(Note: it is not required that you arrive before the judges' meeting, but this time will allow you to make a preliminary examination before talking with the students.)
- 2:45 p.m. **Judges' Meeting.** (Attendance at this meeting is VERY important)
- 3:15 p.m. Judge exhibits. Students will be present to answer your questions. Turn in judging sheets by 5:45 p.m.
- 6:00 p.m. Complimentary reception for judges.

The categories to be judged are **biology, health-medicine, environmental science, behavioral science, chemistry, physics, math-computer science, earth-space, and engineering**. Please indicate on the enclosed form the category you would prefer. This will improve our judging assignments.

This is a big event in the lives of participating students and your support is urgently needed. Complete the enclosed form, mark the date on your calendar and drop the form in the mail.

Details concerning location of the exhibits, free parking arrangements, and a map of the campus and surrounding area will be sent out at the end of February.
